The meeting was called to order by Stephen Hage at 7:06 pm.

Mikado discussion/decision – Stephen: A discussion was had regarding the conversation Stephen had with Rick Shiomi and changes being proposed to *The Mikado* for 2019.

The show would be set in Edwardian England with all references to Japan and the Japanese being removed. The men are playing cricket in the opening song. Character names have been changed as follows: Franky-Poo, Cole Coe, Pooh-Bah, Chris-Tush, Tum Tum, Patti-Sing, Bow-Peep, and Katy Shaw. The character of Katy Shaw was changed to emphasize her strong personality rather than her being grotesque. Song wording would also be changed

Mr. Shiomi would like G & S to have a more diverse cast with more Asians as principals Stephen explained the Grandparenting process to Mr. Shiomi.

What does G & S lose with this interpretation? Should the setting reflect a time in England when executions were commonplace?

There would be an allegory shift-from Japan to England, thus possibly losing the exotic effect.

A vote was taken regarding doing the Mikado in 2019: 7 for doing the show with Rick Shiomi's interpretation and 2 against with 2 abstaining.

Summer Concert Update: All is fine. Chris Mikaela is able to do the role of the Mikado. The first rehearsal is Thursday, June 16, 2016.
