Sitzprobe will be Monday, July 27 at LHUMC. The Technical Rehearsal is Tuesday, July 28. We will be given 3 hours to rehearse in the theater. We are in need of more men-we have 5 tenors and 5 basses, but Leslie would like 2 more to put 8 men in the jury and 4 in the public. Post cards need to be ordered to be handed out at the Lake Harriet Concert. Wally will contact Amber Bjork regarding publicity, American Jewish World will send a reviewer as well as Daily Planet, Cherry and Spoon and 1 Girl, 2 Cities. Wally will do the program with Richard's format and an insert for patrons e-mails and addresses.

Other business:

The board is considering offering 2 comps to cast members for opening night and the second Friday of the run

Wally would like to start selling tickets in December with flyers going out then as well. He will either talk to Richard or Charlotte about this.

We are currently low on t-shirts on some sizes. Wally will ask about selling them at the Fringe
